TRANSPORTATION

(Week 1) Please be at St. Sophia Cathedral no later than 9:00 a.m. on Monday, June 28th.

The bus will take the campers to Lazy W. Ranch Camp in San Juan Capistrano, and bring the campers back on Friday, July 2nd at 2:30 p.m.
